This person would need to be available every Sunday am for an hour and a half. The pay is \$10 per hour. This position begins Sunday, December 2nd.

3. Administrative Assistant. This is a new position at The Chapel and begins ASAP. The pay is \$12 per hour with a maximum of 20 hours per week.

Haley's Experience

Two weeks ago I had to have surgery done on my back. I had to have a mole removed. I didn't know how many stitches I was going to have, but I estimated that it would be around five. As many of you would have been, I was nervous. I wanted to be put to sleep because I didn't want to feel anything. When the nurse, Nurse Mary, came in, she told me exactly what would happen. My mom said that I probably wouldn't remember anything when I woke up. They gave me a pain medicine and a goofy medicine. They both tasted horrible! I don't remember much after they took me back. All I remember is that I said bye to mom and dad like a two year old. Dad told me that I woke up in the room and didn't know where I was. At first I thought he was crazy, but then I recalled when mom told me that I probably

wouldn't remember anything. The nurse came in and said that I did very well and I couldn't do much activity for 2 weeks. I couldn't even do a cartwheel. I normally do one every day. It has been hard not to do one for two weeks. I am all better now but it has been tough having stitches. I know that God was with me the whole time. He spoke through my mom giving me advice, the nurse helping me not to be nervous, and my dad coming to the hospital even though he was in the middle of work. I know that God is always with you, too. I am glad that I got to share this experience with you. If you have any interesting experiences, please tell them to me. I'd love to hear all the ways God has changed your life too.
