



Colossíans 3:7-15

n these you too once walked, when you were living in them. But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth. Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator. Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free: but Christ is all, and in all.

Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.

BARE FLOORS:

Sweep walking surfaces removing dirt, grit, dust, and all foreign objects. Scrub using cleaning solutions to remove dirt: towel-dry all wet surfaces.

CARPETED FLOORS:

Vacuum all open areas removing dirt, dust, and all foreign objects.

DUSTING:

Wet dust all non-wood surfaces including front, sides and kick boards, towel dry. Dry dust and polish all wooden surfaces.

Wet dust floor baseboards removing all foreign objects; spot clean as needed.

KITCHENS:

Remove all items from countertops and wash with soapy water; towel dry. Hand-wash all appliances with soapy water, towel dry. Hand-wash all cabinet fronts and exposed sides with soapy water, towel dry.

Wash all cooking surfaces with soapy water, rinse with clean water, towel dry. Clean oven with grease-removing solution, rinse with clean water, towel dry.

BATHROOMS:

Remove all items from countertops and wash with soapy water; towel dry. Wash all cabinets with soapy water, towel dry. Wash all porcelain surfaces and all mirrored surfaces, towel dry. Mop floors, wash baseboards and towel dry.
