call us to rejoice in thee.




3. Thou art giving

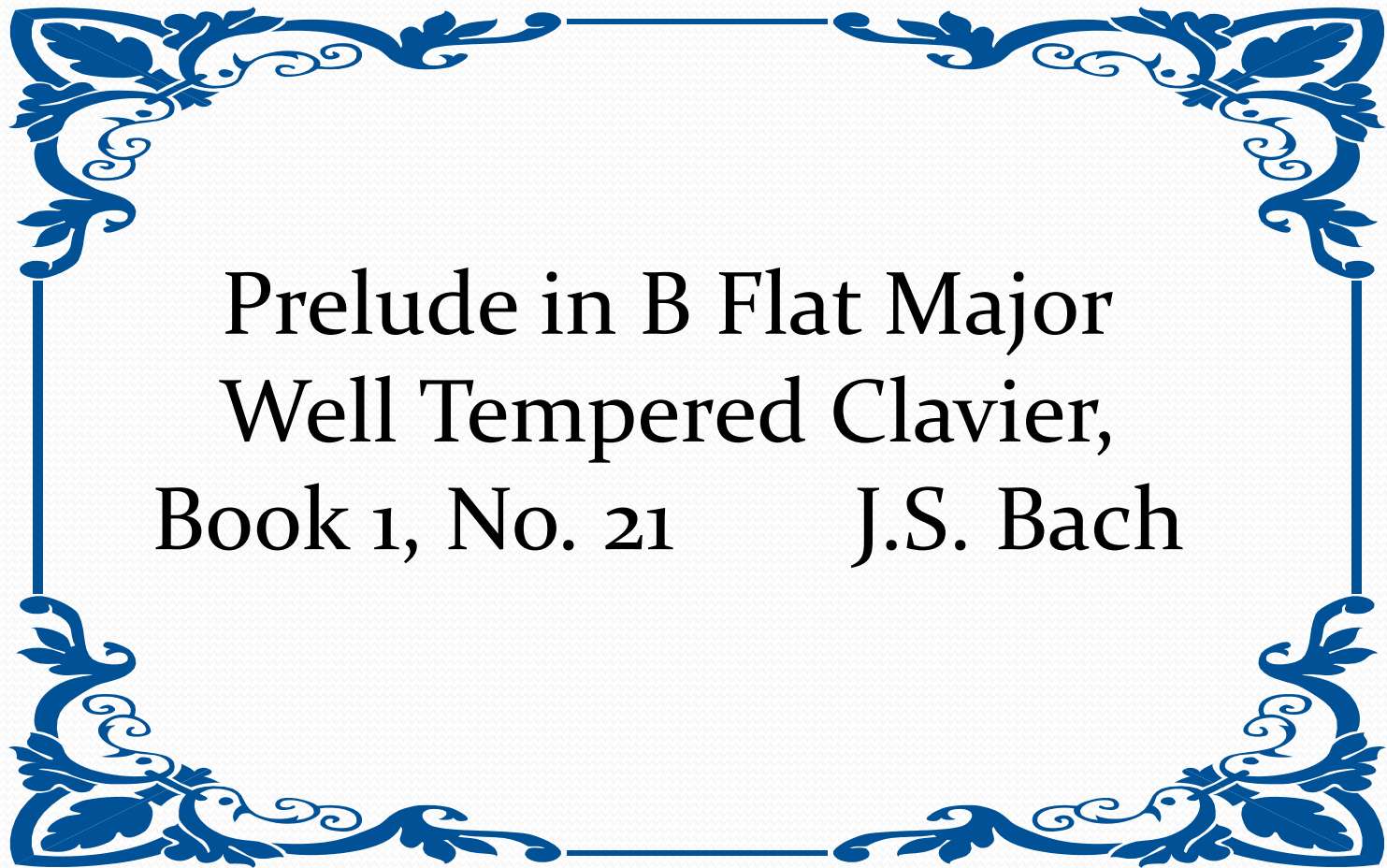
