Current Sermon Series Sinning Like a Christian: A new look at the 7 Deadly Sins

People may say that Christians are too

judgmental, that we talk too much about sin, but it seems that the problem really is that we talk too much about other people's sins - pointing out the proverbial speck in others' eyes while ignoring the logs in our own. We all know that we fall short of God's ideals for us, but too often prefer not to dwell on the specifics of our own sinfulness. During this sermon series we will dwell on our own shortcomings and find God's compassion waiting.

We like to comfort ourselves with the fact we haven't committed certain "big" sins, but what makes the Seven Deadly Sins (which are not directly biblical) perhaps more incisive than the Ten Commandments is their smallness, their personalness. So what makes it meaningful to sing to God in choir? Choir is more than a bunch of people singing together. Choir is about mutual respect, love and support as brothers and sisters in Christ. During a particularly low point in my life, I considered giving up music entirely, but I heard this particular song hummed by a fellow choir member. I asked what it was, because it was one of those songs that sounded familiar, but I didn't know the words. She said her mother used to sing it in the kitchen. I looked up the words and I was amazed by the message God had sent me through this fellow choir member. The words and tune sustained me. I realized that I was tired, physically tired and emotionally spent, but that giving music to God was sustaining me, not draining me. God was giving back if only I would listen to Him. Within six weeks, I had stumbled across no fewer than three different piano arrangements of this same song and I learned them all and I played them as preludes and communion support. Choir, and being a faithful disciple who serves in choir, is about receiving as well as giving. You can arrive tired and worn out, sing, and leave tired and worn out, but also leave choir refreshed. The words we sing are energy for the soul.
