

Choir News

Everyone, hopefully, invites God into his or her heart when they enter the church. People have lots of different ways of doing that. Sometimes we forget that it is incumbent on us to make the effort to bridge the gap we create by not focusing on Him. God bridges that gap with great love we often do not reciprocate. Formal churches often include something called an "introit", which can be musical or not. An "introit" is something that is meant to focus your mind, your mouth, your heart and your whole being on God. Introits can be Bible passages repeated by a church leader, such as "This is the day that the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad in it!" That is an introit. It can be a prayer or a prelude played on an instrument that makes us hush our minds and focus on God or it can be a choir singing a song. One of my favorite ways to enter into God's house with thanksgiving and a worshipful attitude is to think of words to a song or hymn that remind me of God, so that I become centered on what those words mean. Recently, someone reminded me of such words. I know several old American tunes to which they are set, but it's the words that I hope ring home, because this is really a song of praise to God that focuses your attention on God just the way an introit should. Here are the words.

Come Thou fount of every blessing Tune my heart to sing Thy grace. Streams of mercy never ceasing Call for songs of loudest praise. Teach me some melodious sonnet Sung by flaming tongues above Praise the mount! I'm fixed upon it, Mount of Thy redeeming love.

In future months, the choir will be singing at the beginning of the service sometimes, a tune to help you focus your mind and heart on God. I hope when we do that you will join us, sing with us if you like, or just let your mind rest in the words that are sung so that it can focus on God and ask, "Come Thou, found of every blessing, tune my heart to sing Thy grace."
