Choir News

It is amazing to me how much of the Bible I learned from singing anthems with various choirs.

For example, if I let my thoughts drift, the following come bubbling up:

O clap your hands all ye people. Shout unto God with a voice of triumph...

For His mercy endureth forever...

We are His people and the sheep of His pasture...

The Lord is my light and my salvation....

For unto us a child is born...

And this list goes on and on and I learned it all from singing FIRST. Putting it into Biblical context came with a lot of reading. Educators can tell you that any time you add a sensory experience to a learning experience, you increase the chance of someone grasping the subject matter faster and more accurately. Adding hearing and saying to reading increase your chance of remembering what you read.

So choir functions not only as a means of worshiping God, but also as a means of learning some of the words you can use to worship God. If you have ever arrived a little late to a meeting and then slowly opened the room so that you wouldn't disturb the people already engaged in meeting with one another, then choir can be like that. It is a means of opening a door into the Bible through which you can enter into God's courts with praise. The great thing is that everyone already in the meeting won't find your entrance to be a disturbance at all.

They'll all be glad to see you and welcome you.

O God, we have heard with our ears. Please let us hear with our hearts so that our mouths will open and pour out your praise.
