The Lord is in His Holy Temple Let all the world keep silence.

Lots of worship services are begun with those words all over the world. What do they mean to you? Are they just words that are announced, ignored and float by you? Maybe hearing words like these are just an annoyance and you just want to get on with the first hymn or the announcements or the first prayer. It's hard to know what one thing focuses people on God in worship, because there *isn't* just one thing that works for everyone. In the tradition in which I was raised, certain statements of give and take between the worship leader and the congregation focused all of us together on the gift of God's Presence in our midst and made us more of a family unit.

Worship Leader: O Lord, open Thou our lips.

Congregation: And our mouth shall show forth Thy praise.

What's so special about those two little lines? Well, first, God is the only power at work in the room. Only God instigates action, but He gives us the gift of being reciprocal, of being in a relationship with Him based on our response. Second, we are asking God as obedient and respectful children to let us praise Him. Third, we respond to God, not allow God to respond to us. We proclaim that we will praise Him to the ends of the earth. We want to do it. We are ready to do it. We can't wait. Lunch plans can wait. Chit chat about the ball game can wait. We can't wait to be with God. So, for me, those two little statements carry an awful lot of responsibility. The great thing is that all of my brothers and sisters in Christ carry that responsibility with me and the weight of promising praise becomes light and joyful, like the biggest family ever all sitting down to Sunday dinner together.

Last week, I mentioned invocations, musical and non-musical. Both of the statements I listed above could be non-musical invocations or musical if you hear them set to music. Finding such a statement that works for us is very important as a means of silencing the babble in our heads and getting us to do what we are in church to do, worship God. Sometimes, watching someone light candles focuses us. For some people, hearing the church's bell in the bell tower calling people to worship does it. There is no one answer. Most often, it's not any one thing, but a group of things that achieves this goal. Worship is, after all, a process, a lifelong, all-consuming process. What could be a better way to spend your life than worshiping the God who gave it to you?

That's what church music and worship arts are all about, giving our *time* and *attention* back to God along with the talent God gave to us. I truly believe that voices lifted to God together to speak His Praise are music to God's ears. So, there are no non-musicians in any congregation.
