#### Sermon Series Be Still & Know

October 6 – October 27 Life is full of movement. Movement is not a bad thing. If we are moving, we are living. We are making progress. Movement, though, is also exhausting physically and mentally. In some ways, all this movement can be paralyzing. We feel stuck or caught because though we're moving all over the place there is no direction or meaning behind it. We know we're moving, but we wonder if we're really getting anywhere. God says, "Be still." The scriptures place an importance on intentional time taken to be still before God. This sermon series is focused simply on stopping, slowing down so there can be lasting change.




How does anyone in music ministry approach the idea of silence? That would seem to be the antithesis of music. In fact, one of the toughest things for me in my prayer walk and my time with God is to shut off the music that constantly plays through my mind. One thing I have discovered is that music can both connect me to God and also prevent me from connecting with God. It is vital to my spiritual growth that I know when silence is preferable to praise. Silence is often the greatest praise of God that I can offer, because my silence comes at the moments when I don't feel any need to fill space between God and me. He has already filled it with His sound. I absolutely depend every day on my silent time hanging out with God. I encourage everyone to learn how to be silent. It's harder to do than people realize. You find our attention slipping to outside noises. You hear bugs you never heard. You shuffle your feet. You'll try almost anything not to be still and silent. On the other hand, when that moment of silence finally allows God to indwell, you will never be the same. It is the greatest music I have ever heard and it doesn't make a single sound.
