"All in God's good time" is a phrase I have heard all my life. As an undergraduate piano performance major, I took on some major pianistic works and struggled with more than a few of them. Why? I wasn't a mature enough musicians, for one thing, and I didn't wait for God's good time on some of them, for another. Since then, I've performed most of them, older and wiser for the wait. Time is an essential component of a musician's world. We divide the world into measurements of time and rigidly learn them as young musicians only to use all of that rigidity to learn how NOT to be rigid with our sense of time. That still does not mean we get to play fast when we like and slow when we like or mess around with a composer's intent too much. What it does mean is that we learn how to address complicated concepts of time with greater wisdom and experience. Mastering the art of waiting for God's good time may be one of the ideals that I never achieve, but one of those that is the best thing that I could ever exhibit for other musicians. After all, all time is God's time. Musicianship requires skill development and that takes time, but it always comes together in God's good time.
