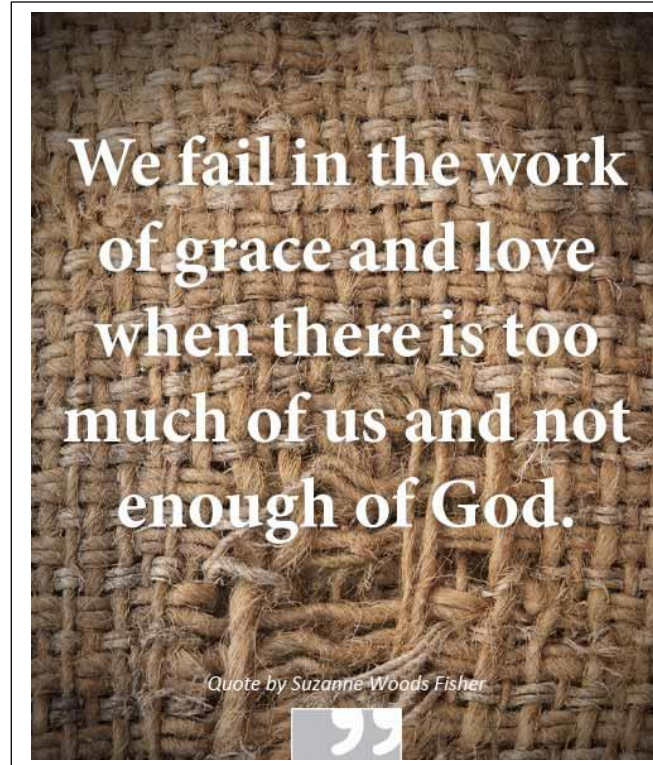

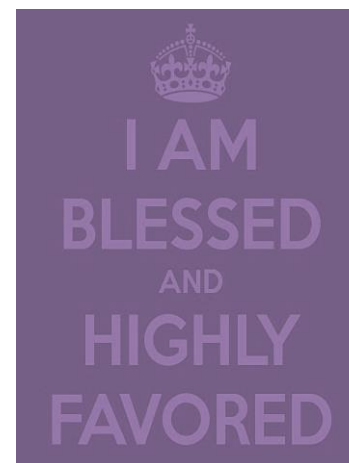
## WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY
