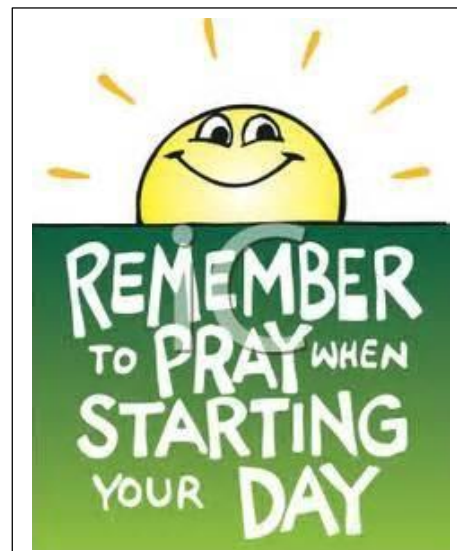

When I was asked recently if I had dreams for the music program at Fields Chapel, I had to spend some time asking God just what that meant. Are we discussing dreams or plans, visions or possibilities? Anything is possible with God. Not everything is within God's Plan.

For well over a year, I have listened carefully to the plans and dreams for music at Field's Chapel as expressed by all of you. I take these requests to God and say, 'what do *You* want?' It's an ongoing process. Some have already been undertaken. For example, one consistently expressed request was for an increase in the use of music written more recently. We've done that, but not to the exclusion of using older hymns and anthems either. In order to do the things I truly believe God wants us to do in terms of music, it requires assistance from the Chapel as a whole, but I have very specific ways in which any or you and all of you can help. Here are two very specific requests:

a. If you know of a Gospel group that is available on a Sunday morning, please provide me with a contact name and telephone number; and,

b. If you, or anyone you know, play an instrument, please provide me with the name and contact information or a piece of music that you would like to play for us.

Contemplative Worship 8:40am Every Sunday

Last October, at The Chapel, we did a sermon series entitled "Be Still". The idea behind the series was to show the importance of being still before God. That only when we are still do we reap the benefits of knowing, hearing, living, experiencing who God is and who we are.

Born from that series was the idea of changing our 8:40 service to a "Contemplative" Service. A time of being still before God so we might know.

Contemplative comes from the word contemplate which means to look thoughtfully at something for a long time. Our Contemplative service offers us the opportunity to be thoughtful, reflective, to meditate. In our busy world, our hectic lives, time taken to bask in the glory of God and be thoughtful about who God is and who we are is seen as almost a crime. Yet it is the one thing, in fact the only thing, that will truly lead us to the union with God that we so desire.

Join us on Sunday mornings as we follow Jesus example of getting away and spending time with God. (By the way, Jesus' time away with God...over and above his commitment to keeping Sabbath) Each Sunday we pray together, we are quite before God. We are thoughtful, reflective and meditate on God's word for us today. We have opportunity to share with one another God's word upon our lives. We also receive communion, and anointing or individual prayer is available.

Being quite is not easy!!! But it is essential, in fact it is life giving. Come, sit, be still and know.

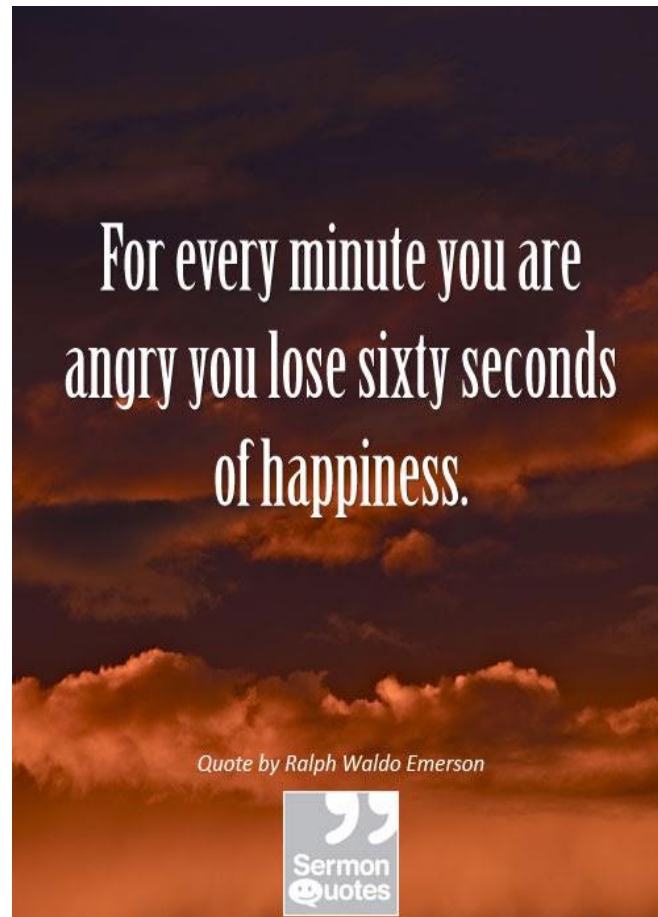


JOYS AND CONCERNS
